


Background

The CSIRO Ginninderra Field Station has played a valuable role and contributed to Australian science through its agriculture and farming research. The site has been identified as underutilised, and the valuable work undertaken there since 1958 will continue at a new location.

The site area is adjacent to your suburb and sits within the Barton Highway, William Slim Drive, Owen Dixon Drive and Kuringa Drive.

We are now investigating future uses of this land. As a first step, CSIRO has requested the National Capital Authority to reclassify the site as 'Urban Area' in the National Capital Plan Draft Amendment due for consultation in September.
