PROPOSED CHILD CARE CENTRE FOR HALL

On 23 March 2014, the Hall and District Progress Association will hold a community meeting at the Hall School grounds to discuss future uses of the Hall School site. The meeting commences at 3.00 pm.

A child care centre has been identified in a report commissioned by the ACT Government as a potential use of part of the Hall School site¹.

As residents of Hall Village, and parents of children who have attended the Hall Preschool, we believe that a child care centre will provide an important community service, and add value and life to Hall and district.

In summary, our proposal entails 3 options:

- 1. Renovating one or more existing structures to make them compliant with current building and child care regulations;
- 2. Removing one or more existing structures and building new structures; or
- 3. Building new structures on a part of the site not currently occupied by buildings.

In all scenarios, the renovations or new buildings will be entirely consistent with Hall's aesthetic and ACT Heritage regulations.
