Dear Resident

Roads ACT, part of TAMS Directorate is responsible for providing traffic and parking controls throughout the ACT. Following consultations with members of the Hall Village Progress Association in relation to the traffic issues on Victoria St and Gladstone St, Roads ACT has conducted investigations and monitored the traffic speed and volume. Listed below are the improvements identified as a result:

- Traffic islands at the intersection of Gladstone St with Victoria St to improve pedestrian accessibility (fig1):

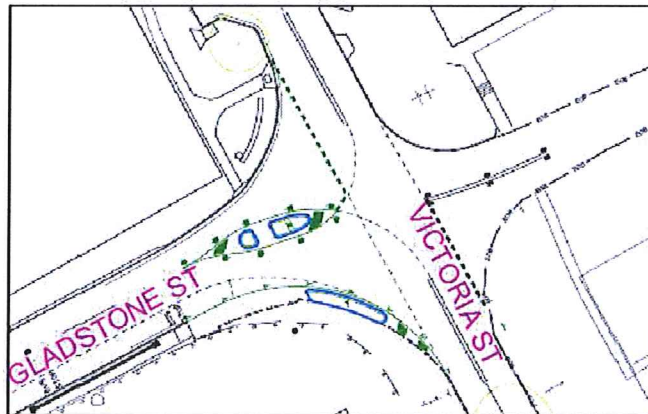

- Removal of redundant and non compliant signs and improvements to the existing speed and warning signs along Victoria St and Gladstone St.

This work will be undertaken as part of Roads ACT Minor New Works Program and is expected to commence after June 30, 2015.

In addition to this, Roads ACT will also undertake some improvements to the shoulder pavement on the western side of Victoria St near the intersection with Gladstone St currently used as a bus lay bay area.
