PROVENANCE DOCUMENT colours

* Blue + Yellow

Hall Village & District Tartan.

Dark Blue - represents the Australian Capital Territory, (ACT) Canberra flag and its association to the Australian National Flag, (British blue ensign technically defaced).

Lime Green - represents the colours today worn by the Rugby League Team known as "Canberra Raiders". Original referred colours, (native bush) used in the design by Ms Patricia Taylor taken from the original Hall Rugby League team registered in 1920.

Light Blue - represents the protected native species. Recorded as "The Royal Blue Bell" (*Wahlenbergia gloriosa*) the floral emblem of the Australian Capital Territory.

Yellow - representing the flag of the Australian Capital Territory on which the Coat of Arms are displayed.

Blue and Yellow - represents the traditional heraldic sporting colours of the Australian Canberra Territory.

Black - represents the Viking emblem displayed by the Canberra Raiders.

White - symbolically represent the Southern Cross Constellation, unique to and viewed only in the Southern Hemisphere.

The "Hall Village & District Tartan" has been designed and registered by principles, Betty & Bradley Johnston of the House of Tartans Australia.
