- 8. be registered for the Goods and Services Tax (GST) if applicable (if turnover is greater than \$150,000 per annum);
- 9. have compliance requirements under the Associations Incorporation Act 1991 up to date; and
- 10have satisfactorily acquitted all previous grants provided by Sport and Recreation (except for current year's funding), including financial acquittals for any other ACT Government agency grant.

Brief Project Description

A Hall community and TCCS project to upgrade the Hall Park to include nature play activities including rope swings, tree and other wooden balance and climbing activities, and, in consultation with indigenous groups, the establishment of a native garden. The upgrade is to provide an improved play space for the village children and residents as well and children from surrounding areas. This upgrade was identified in the 2002 Master Plan for the village so members of the community conducted a fund raising event to facilitate the improvement of the park amenity. We view this as a joint Government and community funded project, with TCCS providing in-kind assistance with the Government requirements and the Hall Village community providing the financial and other in-kind donations to assist the Government contractor to acquire and transport the various materials required for the project.

The condition of the Hall Park has been an issue for the community for a number of years. The need to improve the amenity of the park was identified in the 2002 Hall Master Plan and has been the subject of a number of consultation processes involving a report by Michael Pilbrow (2018) and also the current Hall Park Upgrade Committee involving TCCS, members of the Hall Progress Association, Hall Rotary Club and representatives from within the community who raised \$10,000 from a fund raising event in 2016.

This project directly supports the objectives of the NPGP by significantly increasing opportunities for participation in outdoor recreation, play and adventure activity in Hall Village. The site is currently used by large numbers of children of all ages - including busloads of school children who use the park while they transit through the Village each school day, the many park visitors (the park is a very popular venue for birthdays and barbecues) and the families of Hall Village and surrounding area residents. Through this project, the traditional structured play facility (which is not relevant to a broad age range) will be complemented with a variety of adventure play activities in a natural environment setting. The activities include climbing, exploring, swinging, walking, balancing and running. The ten new playground activities have been selected based on extensive community consultation so we are confident that they will be well received and extensively used. The inclusion of a native "Bush Tucker" garden (developed in consultation with a local Ngunnawal expert advisor) will provide an important cultural/environmental element to our upgraded park experience. The Hall Community has strongly supported this project by raising significant funds and implementation of the upgrade will strengthen social capital.
